COMMENCEMENT SPEAKERS

Dr. David S. Sparks, Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs for the University of Maryland System, represents the UMS Board of Regents at today's ceremonies. In addition to his service with the University of Maryland System, Dr. Sparks has held several positions of prominence at the University of Maryland College Park including Professor of History, Graduate School Associate Dean for the Humanities and Social Sciences, Dean for Graduate Studies and Research, Acting Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Graduate Studies and Research, and Graduate Studies Vice President for Academic Affairs. He has also taught at Johns Hopkins University. He is a member of several learned societies and is an active member of state and national commissions and advisory boards. A graduate of Grinnell College, Dr. Sparks earned M.A. and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Chicago.





Ann Heather Cameron, this year's student speaker, is a native of Williamsport, where she graduated from Williamsport High School in 1987. An Honors Program student and chemistry major, she maintained an overall GPA of 3.99, 4.0 in her field. and received this year's chemistry departmental honors and honors in general education. She is active in the Student Affiliate Chapter of the American Chemical Society and served as treasurer for three years. She was selected by the National Science Foundation to participate in a summer 1990 undergraduate research program at the University of Southern California. Other honors include Outstanding Freshman Chemist, Nelson P. Guild Honors Scholarship, Phi Eta Sigma (freshman honor society) and Kappa Mu Epsilon (mathematics honor society). Ms. Cameron, also vice president of the Honors Student Association, was a tutor in chemistry. Her future plans include graduate work and a career in chemistry.

Dr. Harold Delaney began serving as Interim President of Frostburg State University on February 11, 1991. Dr. Delaney successfully served Morgan State College (now University) for 21 years as Professor of Chemistry and Dean of the College. He subsequently served in a number of prominent positions with State University of New York (SUNY), and with the University of North Carolina System. He was president of Manhattanville College, and Associate Director of the Educational Equity Group, National Institute of Education. He became Executive Vice President of the American Association of State Colleges and Universities (AASCU) in 1977, and was honored with emeritus status in 1987. He was Special Assistant to the Chancellor of the University of Maryland System before accepting the Interim President's position at Chicago State University in 1989. He holds one of the first two doctorates awarded by Howard University (Chemistry, 1958) and maintains memberships in numerous societies and organizations. He and his wife, the former Geraldine East, are the parents of two children.



ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia is a visible reminder that the process of intellectual pursuits has historic and honorable antecedants. The dignity of scholarship in the past remains vital in the present. Academic costumes consist of gowns, hoods and caps.

Originally, academic gowns were an adaptation of priestly toga. They took on brilliant symbolic colors in the medieval universities — for example, purple for doctors of law, green for doctors of medicine, blue for doctors of philosophy. Sober colors were predominant during the Reformation. Gowns did not come into general use in North American universities until late in the last century. Then the brilliant medieval colors were revived. Emerging from black silk gowns increasingly are the color of the college or university which has granted the degree. The doctor's gown has wide lapels of velvet, its sleeves are wide and bell-shaped and there are three velvet sleeve chevrons.

The colorful hoods designate the degree of the wearer, the subject in which the degree is held, and the institution which awarded the degree. The colors of the velvet bands on each hood and robe represent the scholar's field of learning while the official colors of the school awarding the degree are always shown in the lining of the hood.

THE MACE

In the Middle Ages, the mace was a weapon used against armored warriors. It evolved through the years into an ornamental staff which served as a symbol of the authority of the ruler. Colleges and universities have adopted the mace as a decorative staff or baton which is carried by the grand marshal of the institution in all formal academic processions. The mace is also displayed at other significant events.

The Frostburg State University mace was crafted from mountain walnut which was milled in nearby Flintstone, Maryland in 1945. The grain pattern of the quarter-sawn wood was enhanced by laminating side sections to a central shaft which was then turned, point-to-point, on a wood lathe. To obtain a high-gloss finish, ten coats of trewax were applied while mace was turned at high speed on the lathe. The fine detail work around the medallions and the final coating of wax were done by hand.

The design of the Frostburg State University mace is based upon the recorder, a woodwind musical instrument. Two die-struck replicas of the University seal are affixed to the top.

The mace was designed and crafted in 1986 by Dustin Davis of the Frostburg State University Department of Visual Arts.
