

Recommendation On December 10, 2002, the Faculty Senate unanimously approved the following motion on behalf of the faculty at Salisbury University.
"Move that access to social security numbers at Salisbury University be restricted to those instances where social security numbers are required by federal and state law. Furthermore, we do not consent to the use of social security numbers outside of these instances."
The motion was prompted by a realization that faculty social security numbers are being used in ways that do not guarantee the privacy of the faculty and/or security of those numbers.
We are requesting that the Provost, as our conduit to other administrative units, make this known to the relevant administrators for the purpose of stopping the practice of using social security numbers except as specified. The would include, but not be restricted to, all parties involved in the implementation of the Peoplesoft program.
