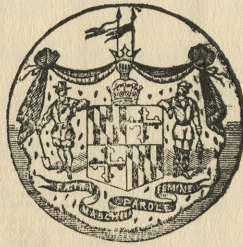

* Hospodee Pomeelooy, meaning Lord Have Mercy, was one of the chants in the service of the Orthodox Church of Old Russia. As the Priest raised the cross on high to give the blessing, the choir followed his movements in a pictorial manner, singing *fff* when his hands were upraised; and as he gradually lowered the cross, the music became softer until it approached a faint whisper. As he raised the cross again, the sound was gradually intensified until at the climax a full-voiced fortissimo was achieved.
