REAL ESTATE BANK.

Advised from New York that the Bank of England has been received in England, and the published correspondence between Mr. Forsyth, the Secretary of State at Washington, and Mr. Livingston, the Minister of America at Paris, between the former and M. Serrurier, French Minister to the United States, and between Mr. Livingston and the Count de Riggy.

The English Conservative Ministry was dissolved, April 8th, after another signal defeat at the hands of the Bonapartists. The Duke of Leiningen, Prince Augustus of Portugal, recently married to the young Queen of Portugal, died at Lisbon, April 28th.

The U. S. Fugitive Constitution arrived at Havre on the 9th.

Resignation of the English Cabinet.

Sir R. Peel was on Tuesday again left in a minority on the resolution moved by Lord John Russell for embodying in the Cabinet the foreign principles adopted by the late ministry of the Irish Church; the numbers being in favor of the resolution 235, against it 222—majority against Ministers 27. The Right Hon. Gentleman had declined in the course of a long able speech in opposition to the motion, that he could not consent to retain office if they were carried, and consequently on Wednesday afternoon he placed the resignation of the Ministry in the hands of the King.

The Right Hon. W. Wellington, in the meeting of the House of Commons, had announced that his Government with the rest of his Colleagues had tendered their resignations, and only held their offices and the appointment of their successors.

VIRGINIA ELECTION.—*Complete.*

The result proves that we were wrong in anticipating the re-election of Wm. P. Taylor, (W) in the 5th district, Rosine Miller, (R) in the 6th, and that the result is probably that the misunderstanding between the Governments of Ohio and Michigan will yet lead to bloodshed; a result scarcely to be expected, and should it occur, deeply to be deplored."

A new Resolution has broken out in Mexico, which threatens to overthrow the present government. It is headed by Gen. Alvarez, who has issued a proclamation that St. Anna is incapable of acting as President. At the last accounts three of the most important States of the Republic had joined, with the State of Zacatecas, of which Alvarez is Governor. St. Anna had marched at the head of 6000 regular troops, to put down the revolt, and a serious conflict was expected.

Banking Capital in Louisiana.—During the recent session of the Legislature, banks with an aggregate amount of fifteen millions of capital have been incorporated. This added to the former amount of banking capital makes nearly \$30 million, which exceeds that of any other State in the Union.

Great Importation of Money.—It appears by the New Orleans Bee of the 15th of last month, that THREE MILLIONS OF DOLLARS, in part of the NINE MILLIONS, lately imported in Holland, for the establishment of the Citizens' Bank of the State of Louisiana, has arrived.

It is officially announced, that the proper authorities of the States of Virginia, Maryland, and Pennsylvania have signified their acceptance of the proposition of the Committee of Correspondence, to contribute \$100,000 each, for the relief of the distressed South, in aid of the State's respective Treasurers, to be used for the payment of the debts due the Bank.
