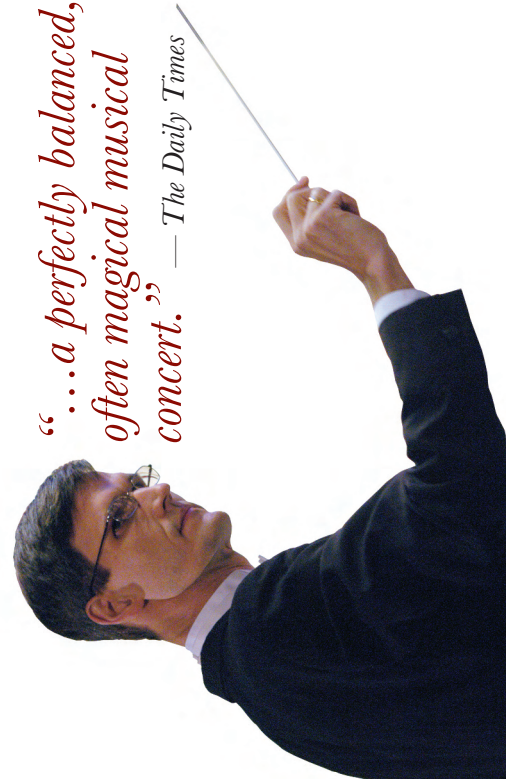

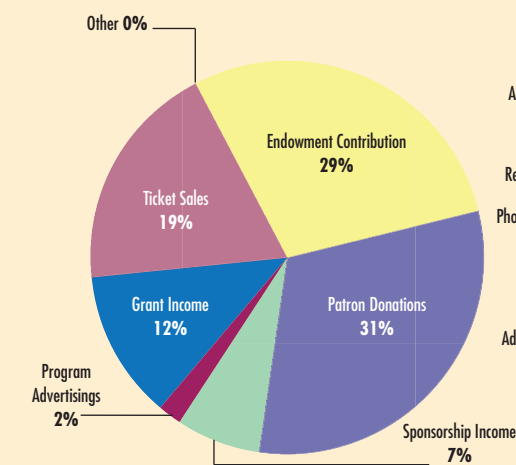

Attendance Figures

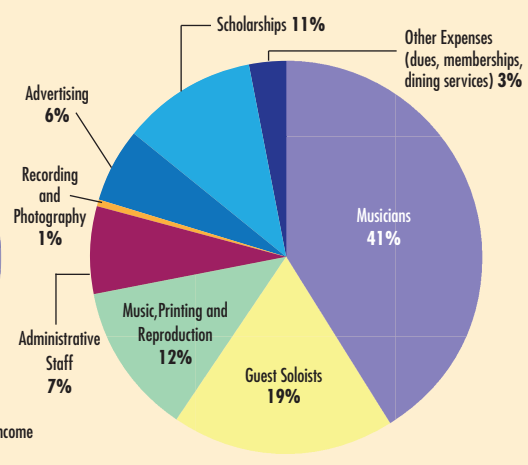
2011-2012 Concert Season Attendance Total = 2,502
