

Dale Kavanagh (Canada) and Thomas Kirchhoff (Germany) have been playing together since 1991. In that time, they have given more than 950 concerts in 40 European countries, Asia, and North and South America, and they have released 16 CDs (Haenssler Classic). Many composers have dedicated works to the duo, including Stephen Dodgson, Gerald Garcia, Harald Genzmer, Jaime Zenamon, Roland Dyens, Stephen Funk-Pearson, Christian Jost and Carlo Domeniconi. In addition to duo concerts, they often perform with orchestra, playing concertos by Rodrigo, Dyens, Genzmer, Domeniconi, Zenamon, Garcia, Jost and Martin Herchenröder.

Dale and Thomas also established and direct one of the largest and most prestigious annual guitar festivals in Europe, the International Guitar Symposium Iserlohn (www.guitarsymposium.com), which draws students from around the world. They live in Iserlohn, Germany, with their daughter Melissa Rachel.
