

## JOHN FRANKLIN MEE

A leading scholar on Management Thought and History, Dr. Mee has developed his perspective on management as an academician, practitioner, and consultant. Currently Mead Johnson Professor of Management at Indiana University's School of Business, Dr. Mee has been active in Richard D. Irwin, Inc., agribusiness and has served as consultant to numerous corporations and the Office of the Pres. of the U.S. Dr. Mee is also a licensed psychologist. In 1972 he received the Taylor Key Award, the highest honor in Management, for his contributions to the field. He is one of the first to indicate that Management Thought has developed in a series of identifiable stages.
