

Draft criteria for forming the (faculty portion of the) Steering Committee to Review General Education:

Balance of the committee: to the extent possible chose faculty volunteers to meet these balance criteria:

If available among the volunteers: one senator from each school.

Library: One librarian, preferably with interest/background in information literacy.

Fulton School:

One person from social science

One person from the humanities

One person from the arts (either visual or performing)

Henson School:

One person from life or health sciences

One person from non-life laboratory sciences

One person from non-lab science (e.g. Math or COSC)

Perdue School:

One faculty member from a department that contributes to general education and one from a department that does not.

Seidel School:

One faculty member from a department that contributes to general education and one from a department that does not.

Total 11 faculty members on the committee plus one faculty co-chair

Also if possible include among the above, minority and international representation.

Qualifications: (to the best of our ability to determine)

Most members (all but at most 2) tenured or permanent status

Ability to work with others, particularly those with whom one disagrees, in a professional and respectful manner

A seeker of solutions; a problem-solver

Excellent communication skills

An open mind
