The only complaints were those of the cafeteria staff who had to clean up the mess left by the picnickers. Nevertheless, it was a memorable, if untidy, event.






#### What Goes on in Here?



December 2, was a day for the Frostburg community to become as children and have endless fun and excitement as the Harlem Globetrotters enthralled everyone with their magical wizardry.



### Mickey's Golden Anniversary










### The Burg Can Be Beautiful Under Ice


By finishing the regular season 6-3-3, the Bobcat soccer team received its first NCAA tournament bid. The Cat booters lost a 1-0 heartbreaking decision to Franklin and Marshall thus ending what many observers felt was one of the best seasons ever for Frostburg State Soccer.

Leading scorers for FSC this year were senior Francisco Castro, who was MVP, with 11 goals and 4 assists; and junior Noel Cyrus with 2 goals and 4 assists. Castro finished his career as FSC's all-time leading point scorer with 38 goals and 18 assists.

Castro, Cyrus, and sophomore Lawrence Sagel were selected to the All-State Soccer team for the second consecutive year.

Other graduating seniors include Doug Zittle, Shawn Hurley, and Dennis Alexander. Sophomore Mark Weber saved 102 shots and allowed only 13 goals.

The 1982 season looks quite promising as many quality players return. Hopefully the Bobcats will make it to the "Final Four" and come home with a National Championship.






There is a girl I know who stopped by this way she didn't stay for so very long she shed her beauty, her goodness, her love and then went on to bless another.




