## **Bylaws for The International Program Committee**

The International Program Committee

The duties and responsibilities of the International Program Committee shall be to:

- develop and evaluate procedures for the establishment of new international education programs and links;
- develop clarify and evaluate procedures for sending University students abroad;
- establish standard procedures for study abroad/University travel courses working with the School and University Curriculum Committees.
- serve as a resource for international opportunities for faculty;
- advise the Director of International Education on financial disbursements to support faculty and student activities abroad;
- facilitate dialogue regarding the internationalization of the curriculum;

- advocate for international student services; and
- advocate for international student recruitment.

The committee shall be chaired by the Director of International Education (exofficio voting) and shall consist of: two faculty representatives elected from each school serving two-year staggered terms; one designated Senator; one representative from the Admission's Office; one International Students' Services Coordinator; one representative from the Development Office (ex-officio non-voting); and two members of the student body (one international student and one study abroad student; both students are appointed by the Director of International Education) serving one-year terms. Schools which house international programs may wish to allow a director of an international program who is not a faculty member to run for one of the faculty positions on this committee. If such a person is elected by the faculty in the school he/she may be a substitute for the second faculty representative.
