## **University Academic Assessment Committee**

The committee shall have seven voting members: four members elected from and by their respective schools, two elected at-large and one elected representative from and by the Library. The University Provost (or designee) and the Director of University Analysis, Reporting and Assessment (or designee) shall both be non-voting ex officio members. Terms of all elected representatives shall be three (3) years and staggered. Should an elected faculty member not be the Designated Senator, a non-voting Designated Senator shall also serve on the committee. The committee shall elect its chairperson annually.

The committee shall have seven voting members: four members elected from and by their respective schools, two elected at-large and one elected representative from and by the Library. The University Provost (or designee), the Director of University Analysis, Reporting and Assessment (or designee), and **one student, serving a one year term, selected annually in a manner determined by the Student Government Association,** shall be non-voting ex officio members. Terms of all elected representatives shall be three (3) years and staggered. Should an elected faculty member not be the Designated Senator, a non-voting Designated Senator shall also serve on the committee. The committee shall elect its chairperson annually.
