Academic Regalia

Academic regalia is a visible reminder that the process of intellectual pursuits has historic and honorable antecedents. The dignity of scholarship in the past remains vital in the present.

Originally academic gowns were an adaptation of priestly toga. They took on brilliant symbolic colors in the medieval universities— for example, purple for doctors of law, green for doctors of medicine, blue for doctors of philosophy. Sober colors were predominant during the Reformation. Gowns did not come into general use in North American universities until late in the last century. Then the brilliant medieval colors were revived. Emerging from black silk gowns increasingly are the color of the college or university which has granted the degree.

The doctor's gown has wide lapels of velvet, its sleeves are wide and bell-shaped and there are three velvet chevrons. The doctor's hood is bell-shaped; the master's is pointed. The lining emblazons a principal color of the scholar's institution; the border indicates the department of specialty.

Commencement Speakers



Dr. James A. (Dolph) Norton is Interim Chancellor of the University of Maryland System, which includes II campuses and 4 research centers and enrolls over IOO,OOO students. A prominent executive and educator, he has also served as the Chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents, Interim President and Trustee of Hiram College, and as Professor in the Woodrow Wilson Department of Government and Foreign Affairs and Director of the Center for Public Service at the University of Virginia. In addition, he has served as President of the Greater Cleveland Associated Foundation, Director of the Cleveland Foundation, and Executive Director of the Cleveland Metropolitan Services Commission. He is currently a consultant to a number of government agencies, civic organizations, and colleges. Dr. Norton has been National President of the American Society for Public Administration, Chairman and board member of the National Academy of Public Administration, and

Chairman of the Federal Regulations Committee of the State Higher Education Executive Offices. Dr. Norton has been an Urban Scholar in Residence at Cleveland State University, Professor of Area Development at Case Institute of Technology, Professor in Public Administration at Florida State University and an instructor at the Harvard School of Public Health, Louisiana State University, and the University of Texas. He holds undergraduate and graduate degrees from Louisiana State University as well as M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from Harvard University.



Lisa Lynn Mackay graduates with academic honors with a major in mathematics and a minor in music. She has been the recipient of the Academic Merit, the Foundation, the Nelson P. Guild and the Elisabeth Hitchins Scholarships. She has served as music director of Delta Omicron International Music Fraternity and is also a member of Kappa Mu Epsilon math honor society and Phi Eta Sigma freshman honor society. During the 1988-89 academic year, Mackay participated in the International Student Exchange Program at FSU and studied abroad at the University of Ulster at Jordantown located outside of Belfast. She plans graduate work in mathematics after graduation.



Dr. Herb. F. Reinhard, Jr., became Frostburg State University's 12th president in July, 1986. A native of Covington, KY, he has devoted the past twenty-nine years to public education, including the presidencies of Slippery Rock University of PA and Morehead State University of Kentucky. Under President Reinhard's dynamic leadership, the University has attained university status, seen its enrollment increase by 35%, received appropriation increases of 44% and established Schools of Education and Business as well as implementing a new system of campus governance for greater faculty and student involvement. President Reinhard is the immediate past chairman of the Committee on Governance of the Association of State Colleges and Universities and currently serves as a member of its Academic Affairs Committee. He has also been elected by the presidents of NCAA member institutions as a member of both Division I and II of the 44 member President's

Commission of the National Collegiate Athletic Association. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Florida State University and his doctorate from Indiana University. He and his wife, Nancy, are the parents of four children.
