The following shall be the policy of the Faculty Senate regarding elections, referenda, or other votes conducted by the Membership and Elections Committee:

The Membership and Elections Committee shall provide public results concerning elections, referenda, or other votes which the Committee conducts. In particular,

A) After every election, the Membership and Elections Committee shall provide a public written report listing all contests, the candidates in each contest, the number of votes cast in each contest, and the winner(s) (if any).

B) Within 15 days upon the completion of any election, a losing candidate in any contest can request that the chair of the Membership and Elections Committee divulge the number of votes cast both for themselves and for the winning candidate.

C) After every referendum or other vote conducted by the Membership and Elections Committee, the Committee shall provide a public written report listing all matters and options voted upon, the number of votes cast for each matter or option, the number of votes received for and against each matter or option, and the result(s) of the voting.
