Graduation with University Honors

Students must complete a minimum of 56 graded hours of coursework at Salisbury University, in which at least 30 hours of 300/400-level courses are completed with grades of A, B or C. In addition, students must have minimum Salisbury University grade point averages as follows:

CUM LAUDE - 3.5

MAGNA CUM LAUDE - 3.7

SUMMA CUM LAUDE - 3.9

Students completing a second bachelor's degree will be eligible to graduate with honors only if they meet all graduation with honors criteria using credits earned after their prior graduation.

Graduation with Thomas E. Bellavance Honors

Students graduating with Thomas E. Bellavance Honors have completed at least 22 hours of coursework in the Thomas E. Bellavance Honors Program, and have completed either a Junior Year Research Project or a Senior Honors Thesis. A minimum grade point average of 3.5 is also required.

Students graduating with Thomas E. Bellavance Honors With Distinction have completed at least 22 hours of coursework in the Thomas E. Bellavance Honors Program, a junior year research project and a Senior Honors Thesis. A minimum grade point average of 3.5 is also required.

(Today's recognition of graduates and those who will achieve University and Thomas E. Bellavance Honors is tentative pending certification of all graduation requirements.)

Honorary Degrees

Salisbury University awards honorary degrees at commencement exercises on the basis of recommendation by an ad hoc honorary degree committee and approval of the provost, University president and the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland. There is no expectation that Salisbury University will award one or more honorary degrees at each commencement exercise.

Academic Regalia

The traditional caps and gowns worn by students and faculty in the academic procession have been the historic costume of scholars since medieval times. Because many scholars of that period were members of monastic orders, the academic costume resembles ecclesiastical dress.

A uniform code for academic costumes was drafted by an intercollegiate commission in 1893 and has since been adopted by the majority of colleges and universities in the United States. Each of the three academic degrees—bachelor's, master's and doctor's—has its own distinctive gown and hood. The gown representing the bachelor's degree is distinguished by its long, pointed sleeve. The master's gown has a longer, narrow closed sleeve, extending below the knee; the arm is passed through a slit at the elbow. In contrast, the doctor's gown has a full, bell-shaped sleeve with three bars of velvet. The opening of this gown is faced with wide velvet bands, which may be black or of a color indicating the general field of learning of the wearer—for example, dark blue for philosophy, green for medicine, purple for law, and light blue for education.

The most colorful and distinctive item of the academic costume is the hood, which passes around the neck and extends down the back. The colors of the silk lining exposed in the center of the hood are those of the college or university which conferred the degree.
