














PROWLIN'&, PLAYIN' AT HOMECOMING

CAMPUS CONSERVATION

The university is exploring new ways to preserve its resources and create methods for sustainability in its home town of Frostburg. In April 2008, the campus purchased six 2008 Honda Civic Hybrid vehicles in an effort to cut down on carbon emissions. Every Tuesday, the Student Sierra Coalition hosts a "Blackout Day" when students, faculty, and staff are requested to use little to no electronics in an effort to conserve energy for one hour from noon to 1:00 pm. Blue recycling receptacles are positioned across campus to encourage the recycling of aluminum, paper, and plastic. In addition to these physical efforts of sustainability, students in an English 402 class released \underline{E} =(LG)2 Magazine in December 2008 in an effort to promote sustainability from a student perspective. Each of these examples demonstrates the university's commitment toward an environment-friendly future.













HEALTHY & HAPPY SCHOOL WELLNESS

Wellness is a big part of life and Frostburg State University has taken an active role in making sure its students are healthy and active. Frostburg has created a program called CHILL, which is short for Creating Healthy. Informed, Lasting, Lifestvies, and its sole purpose is ensuring the health of the university's students, faculty, and staff. CHILL has sponsored various programs on campus this year as informative resources to the campus community, such as student health screenings, smoking and substance abuse prevention plans, and the development of a variety of campus-wide activities all geared toward a healthy lifestyle. Frostburg is making a conscious effort to distribute educational information to the student body about the importance of regular exercise and proper nutrition. April Baer, FSU's Project Coordinator for University Wellness, planned and helped during most of CHILL's events here on campus, including the biomedical screenings that were held in the Lane Center. The main event coordinated by CHILL was: "Let's Walk, Let's CHILL." The top student winner, freshman Robbie Wullschleger, walked and ran for more than 102 miles and exercised for more than 73 hours during the course of the competition. The top faculty winner, Jaron Hawkins, a lecturer in the Geography department, logged over 485 miles of walking and running. These two were recognized and awarded during half time of the Homecoming Football Game. The Brady Health Center also promoted Wellness on campus by having a nutritionist on staff that anyone can make an appointment with, in order to get on a healthy diet. CHILLVILLE, a series of programs for CHILL, lasted several days from November 3 to November 12 with various events including a game of dodgeball.



ORIGIN OF THE NEMACOLIN



Nemacolin, a Delaware Indian, was asked by Thomas Cresap, the first white settler in Western Maryland and founder of Cresaptown, to blaze a trail westward from Cumberland. This trail, known as "Nemacolin's Path" became U.S. Route 40, the first major road to connect the East and West. Frostburg State University was founded on this trail, thus, the yearbook assumed Nemacolin's name. "Sports do not build character. They reveal it." - Heywood Broun



FOOTBALL

One of the team's most significant games this season was against SUNY Brockport, whom Frostburg State University had not beaten in ten years. The final score resulted in a win of 27-14, which made the first home game of the season a spectacular win. Head Coach Tom Rogish was impressed with the intensity of the team this season and their "never quitting" attitude. The football team achieved another victorious moment of the season when the team won its first conference game in three years. Rogish expects that by next year the team will vastly improve. 








Above: Lauren Lentine uses her footwork to work her way down the field.


WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY



Above: Christina Aumand works on her breathing as she runs in order to stay in front of her competitor.











MEN'S SWIMMING & DIVING








Above: The freestyle is one of the most well-known forms of swimming and Bill Ford shows it off very well.

Men's Track & Field

The Men's Track and Field started with the largest team Frostburg has seen in over 8 years. The indoor season moved quickly as we competed in over 11 meets, traveling to over 9 states. The men took 5th place this season in the Mason Dixon Conference Championships. On the men's team Brian Leiter competed in the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference. Leiter captured 1st in the 800 meter run, just missing the ECAC record. With ECAC's over, Leiter progressed to the Indoor National Championships being held in Terra Haute, Indiana. Leiter competed in the one mile; running a season's best and school record time of 4:10.08. He captured 4th place and as a result was named an All-American, for the 2nd time in his career. With the indoor season ending the Bobcats quickly returned to action running their first outdoor meet only one week later. The Bobcats will be hosting the Conference Championships for the first time in over 12 years this spring, inviting over 10 schools to participate in the meet. They predict a strong showing as the team has increased in size, talent, support, and work ethic. Soon after the completion of the Conference Championships over 23 athletes will continue on to compete in Springfield, Massachusetts at the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference, while Brian Leiter, and hopefully a few of his teammates will compete at the 2009 Outdoor National Championships being held in Marietta, Ohio.












Above Right: Timothy Sutcliffe crouches in order to get in better position to catch the ball.

Above: Freddy Foshay gets prepared to throw the ball to first to get an out.




Above: Trevor Conner makes a pitch in hopes to get a third strike.

Softball




