Motion to charge an Ad Hoc Faculty Workload Committee with serving in an advisory capacity to the Provost.

Whereas, the SU Provost serves as a member of the USM Faculty Workload Committee to evaluate how faculty workload is measured across USM institutions; and whereas, University Analysis, Reporting, & Assessment (UARA) is meeting with department chairs about current faculty workloads; and whereas, the current system-wide formula does not account for all faculty work which results in an inequitable comparison between institutions; and whereas, it is imperative that Faculty Senate be actively involved in workload measures;

We, the Faculty Senate, charge the Ad Hoc Faculty Workload Committee, consisting of the following Senators representing the four schools; Drs. John Nieves (Fulton), Randy Cone (Henson), Steve Adams (Perdue), and Doug DeWitt (Seidel), to serve as a consultative body to the Provost to aid in revising faculty workload descriptions.

Periodic reports will be given to the Faculty Senate based on on-going conversations with the Provost.
