

DIRECTOR NOTES

Welcome to the 2019 Fall Student Dance Showcase! As director of the SU Dance Company, I invite you to sit back, turn off your phone and let the world slip away for a bit as you enjoy this special cultural event.

This concert showcases the work of *many* talented students. These dances are conceived, choreographed and performed by students. All are current SU students with one exception – the last dance on this concert is choreographed by Emily Lane, a 2019 graduate of SU and long-time Dance Company member.

The dance titled "Klezmer Rhapsody" features a series of short solos and duets set to contemporary Klezmer music. These students are guest performers from the DANC 490, Dance Choreography class. Each performer has choreographed their own solo, structuring their work around a theme or artistic inspiration. It is the music that bonds these short works into a unified piece.

All of the other dances on the concert are created by SU Dance Company members who submitted their ideas for their piece last summer, and have been hard at work rehearsing since early September. Each dance highlights that choreographer's inspiration and sense of design. I recommend observing each dance as you would a short story or poem.

Many people get nervous if they don't immediately "get" a work of art. Let your mind be at ease and allow the emotions/sensations of each dance to wash over you. We are presenting these pieces for your aesthetic response and your pleasure. Don't worry about the meaning – we want you to relax and enjoy the concert!
