COMMENCEMENT SPEAKERS

David Roger Jones

A scholar, a volunteer, a teacher. All these terms describe the student chosen to speak at this Commencement ceremony. Accomplished, enthusiastic and capable, David Roger Jones epitomizes the concerned University student. He has tutored low-income housing project students, and for two summers served as a residential counselor for the FSU Upward Bound Program. In pursuing his educational career, he spent April through June of 1992 as a substitute teacher at Glen Burnie High School. Additionally, Mr. Jones has served for several years as a head basketball coach for grades K-4 and 5-8 in the Fearer Memorial League and is an umpire



for Little League Baseball here in Allegany County. A Big Brother with the Big Brothers/Big Sisters of the Alleghenies, he also volunteers with the local Meals-on-Wheels program. A Dean's list student and recipient of several academic scholarships while a student at FSU, Mr. Jones plans a career teaching social sciences on the secondary level.



Alta E. Schrock, Ph.D.

Selected to receive FSU's honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree, Dr. Alta Schrock is a life-long friend of the tri-state area. A student of nature since her childhood, in 1944 she became the first Mennonite woman to earn a doctorate, in biology at the University of Pittsburgh. She performed relief work in Europe and taught at the college level (including 17 years at FSU), but is perhaps best known as a pillar of support for the preservation and promotion of the traditions and crafts of the Upper Appalachian mountain people, to whom she has devoted much of her time, efforts and resources since 1957. She is founder and has served as leader of several community

programs, such as the Springs Historical Society, Folk Festival and Museum of Early Settlers and Penn Alps, Inc., among others, and is now organizing Friedensheim, or House of Peace. This latest endeavor will provide a place of spiritual, emotional and physical renewal in a Christian environment. In 1989 she was named to the Community Action (Maryland) Hall of Fame, was an Honorary Golden Ambassador to the Garrett County Autumn Glory Festival in 1990 and named to the Maryland Women's Hall of Fame, 1991. Dr. Schrock continues to live and work in Garrett County.

Dr. Catherine R. Gira became the President of Frostburg State University on September 1, 1991. Prior to that, she served for nine years as Provost at the University of Baltimore. She also previously held the positions of Professor of English and Acting Dean of the College of Liberal Arts at that institution. Dr. Gira has held leadership positions in numerous national and state professional associations including the American Association of University Administrators (President, 1988-90); Federation of State Humanities Councils (Board of Directors, 1991-present); Maryland Humanities Council (Chair, 1989-91) and Maryland Association of Higher Education (President, 1986-87). She earned a B.S. from California University of



Pennsylvania, an M.Ed. and a Masters in Liberal Arts from The Johns Hopkins University, and a Ph.D. in Literature from The American University. She has published numerous articles on Shakespeare, Renaissance art and literature, and issues in higher education. She is currently completing a bibliographic and critical study of Shakespeare's Henry IV.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia is a visible reminder that the process of intellectual pursuits has historic and honorable antecedents. The dignity of scholarship in the past remains vital in the present. Academic costumes consist of gowns,

hoods and caps.

Originally, academic gowns were an adaptation of priestly toga. They took on brilliant symbolic colors in the medieval universities — for example, purple for doctors of law, green for doctors of medicine, blue for doctors of philosophy. Sober colors were predominant during the Reformation. Gowns did not come into general use in North American universities until late in the last century. Then the brilliant medieval colors were revived. Emerging from black silk gowns increasingly are the color of the college or university which has granted the degree. The doctor's gown has wide lapels of velvet, its sleeves are wide and bell-shaped and there are three velvet sleeve chevrons.

The colorful hoods designate the degree of the wearer, the subject in which the degree is held, and the institution which awarded the degree. The colors of the velvet bands on each hood and robe represent the scholar's field of learning while the official colors of the school awarding the degree are always

shown in the lining of the hood.

THE MACE

In the Middle Ages, the mace was a weapon used against armored warriors. It evolved through the years into an ornamental staff which served as a symbol of the authority of the ruler. Colleges and universities have adopted the mace as a decorative staff or baton which is carried by the grand marshal of the institution in all formal academic processions. The mace is also displayed at other significant events.

The Frostburg State University mace was crafted from mountain walnut which was milled in nearby Flintstone, Maryland in 1945. The grain pattern of the quarter-sawn wood was enhanced by laminating side sections to a central shaft which was then turned, point-to-point, on a wood lathe. To obtain a high-gloss finish, ten coats of trewax were applied while mace was turned at high speed on the lathe. The fine detail work around the medallions and the final coating of wax were done by hand.

The design of the Frostburg State University mace is based upon the recorder, a woodwind musical instrument. Two die-struck replicas of the

University seal are affixed to the top.

The mace was designed and crafted in 1986 by Dustin Davis of the Frostburg State University Department of Visual Arts.
