



COMMENCEMENT SPEAKERS

Marc Edward Shapiro of Dayton, Ohio, graduates today with a Bachelor of Science degree, with a major in history and a minor in geography. As a student at Frostburg State University, he has served as president of Phi Alpha Theta, the national history honorary society, and president of the Residence Hall Association. He has held the position of National Residence Hall Honorary regional recruiter for the National Association of College and University Residence Halls. A member of the Student Alumni Ambassadors and NRHH, Shapiro has also been director of the Telemarketing Program in the Office of Admissions and a university student tutor. In addition, he has been a student assistant during Summer Planning Conferences and has served on several other campus committees.



Dr. Herb. F. Reinhard became the University's 12th president in July 1986. A native of Covington, Kentucky, he has devoted the past twenty-nine years to public higher education, including the presidencies of Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania and Morehead State University of Kentucky. President Reinhard is a member of the Academic Affairs Committee of the American Association of State Colleges and Universities and served as a member from both Division I and II of the 44-member President's Commission of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA). He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Florida State University and the doctorate from Indiana University. He and his wife, Nancy, are the parents of four children.



ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia is a visible reminder that the process of intellectual pursuits has historic and honorable antecedents. The dignity of scholarship in the past remains vital in the present. Academic costumes consist of gowns, hoods and caps.

Originally, academic gowns were an adaptation of priestly toga. They took on brilliant symbolic colors in the medieval universities — for example, purple for doctors of law, green for doctors of medicine, blue for doctors of philosophy. Sober colors were predominant during the Reformation. Gowns did not come into general use in North American universities until late in the last century. Then the brilliant medieval colors were revived. Emerging from black silk gowns increasingly are the color of the college or university which has granted the degree. The doctor's gown has wide lapels of velvet, its sleeves are wide and bell-shaped and there are three velvet sleeve chevrons.

The colorful hoods designate the degree of the wearer, the subject in which the degree is held, and the institution which awarded the degree. The colors of the velvet bands on each hood and robe represent the scholar's field of learning while the official colors of the school awarding the degree are always shown in the lining of the hood.

THE MACE

In the Middle Ages, the mace was a weapon used against armored warriors. It evolved through the years into an ornamental staff which served as a symbol of the authority of the ruler. Colleges and universities have adopted the mace as an decorative staff or baton which is carried by the grand marshal of the institution in all formal academic processions. The mace is also displayed at other significant events.

The Frostburg State University mace was crafted from mountain walnut which was milled in nearby Flintstone, Maryland in 1945. The grain pattern of the quarter-sawn wood was enhanced by laminating side sections to a central shaft which was then turned, point-to-point, on a wood lathe. To obtain a high-gloss finish, ten coats of trewax were applied while mace was turned at high speed on the lathe. The fine detail work around the medallions and the final coating of wax were done by hand.

The design of the Frostburg State University mace is based upon the recorder, a woodwind musical instrument. Two die-struck replicas of the University seal are affixed to the top.

The mace was designed and crafted in 1986 by Dustin Davis of the Frostburg State University Department of Visual Arts.
