John Allison Award to be Given to Outstanding Seniors

Seeking an appropriate way to honor graduating students at Frostburg State College, the Alumni Association is establishing the John Allison Outstanding Senior Awards.

The awards will be presented for scholarship, leadership, and service. Presentation will be made at Alumni Day, April 29.

The awards are named for the late Mr. John Allison, psychology professor and counselor emeritus at Frostburg. He was a member of the faculty from 1959 until his retirement in 1972.

In 1971, he received the first honorary degree, Doctor of Humane Letters, conferred by the College.

These new awards will be presented in place of the Who's Who awards made in past years.

Mr. Allison, in addition to his teaching duties, was the first student counselor at the College and coordinated the work study programs at the school. He served as the College's first director of financial aid and participated as an advisor in many student ac-

tivities. In working with the student loan program, he personally guaranteed many of the loans he arranged.

Certificates for the John Allison Outstanding Senior Awards will be provided by funds from the Frostburg State College Foundation.

To be eligible for the award, a student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or better and have demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities. Service to both the College and the community are also considered in selecting recipients.

To be considered, a student must expect to complete graduation requirements by September, 1978. Applicants will be selected for nomination by a committee of three students and three faculty members. Final selection will be made by a five-member Alumni Association Committee.

Application forms are available in the Student Association offices, the Student Affairs Office and the Alumni Office, both in Lowndes Hall.

Overtime Funds Expended By Campus Police

According to Mr. Robert Merican, Head of the Frostburg State College Security Department, the financial crisis has affected Campus Police. In essence, the Security Department has expended all its overtime funds and must now cut back on such services as being present at dances and special events.

Previously, one or two officers have been situated in around at these events in the case of fights, accidents, and any other problems. This will now cease. Mr. Merican stated that he hoped this overtime cut "will not affect the safety of students." In compliance with this, the security around the dorms will not be lessened. The heaviest shift from 6 p.m. to 3 a.m. will remain the same as before.

Students can take some of the burden off Security by making sure their entrance doors are locked after 11:00 p.m. Often doors are found unlocked at 1:00 and 2:00 a.m. Also by only calling Security when they are really needed, the effects of this cutback may not be noticed.

Nominations may be made by faculty, organizations, or by the students themselves. Nominations must be made by February 24 and applications must be returned to the Alumni Office, Rm. 220D, Lowndes Hall by March 3.

Faculty Advisors Evaluated

In an effort to compare and contrast Peer Advisors and the Faculty Advisor System, State-to-Date offers the first of two random polls, which deals with the Faculty Advising Program. To compare with the P.A. poll, seventy five Upperclassmen were polled.

Although faculty advisors would seem most valuable in clarifying major requirements, one-third of the students polled had not discussed this subject with their advisors. Only thirty Upperclassmen had even discussed college graduation requirements with the appointed advisor.

The greatest reason for contact with an advisor was to have a drop add slip or a pass/non pass form signed. Half of the students responded that the meeting consisted of simply signing the form, with only thirty one students having actual discussion. One student stated that her advisor "signed the form before I'd decided what courses I'd actually take."

Many Upperclassmen, when asked to fill out the poll, could not remember who their faculty advisor's were. In concurrence with this, sixty three students saw their advisors eight times or less, and six stu-

dents had never seen them.

As far as individual advice, sixty students had not taken any teacher problems to their advisor.

Although forty three students polled felt that they didn't receive individualized advice from their advisor, over half of the respondents felt satisfied with the advising they received. One student stated that her advisor could not offer advice because "he doesn't have any idea what kind of person I am." Other comments include, "my advisor is never available to meet with me," and "my advisor couldn't care less about offering individual advice."

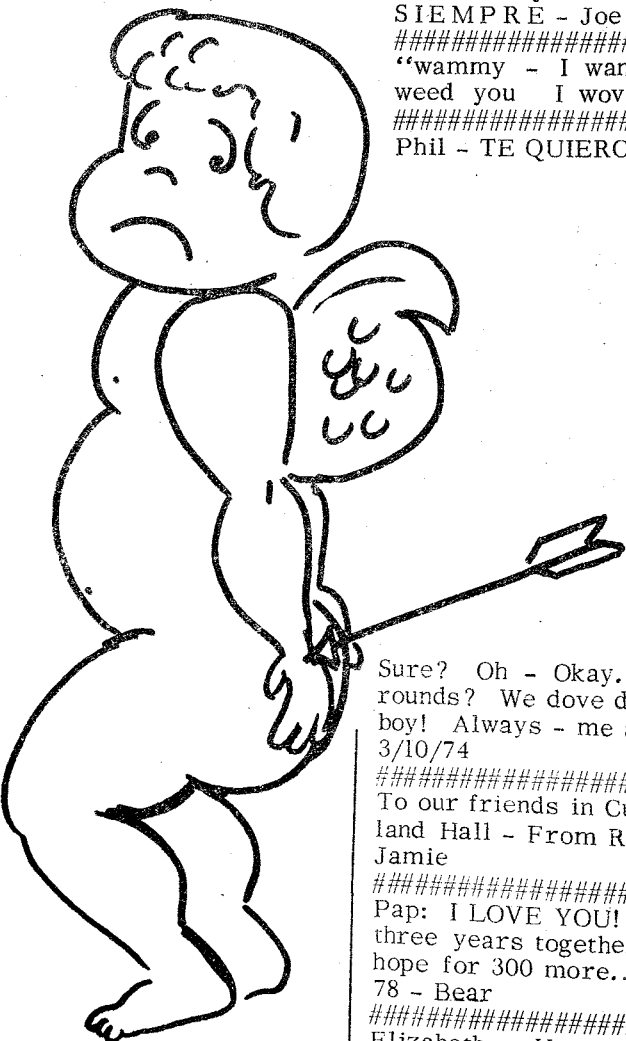

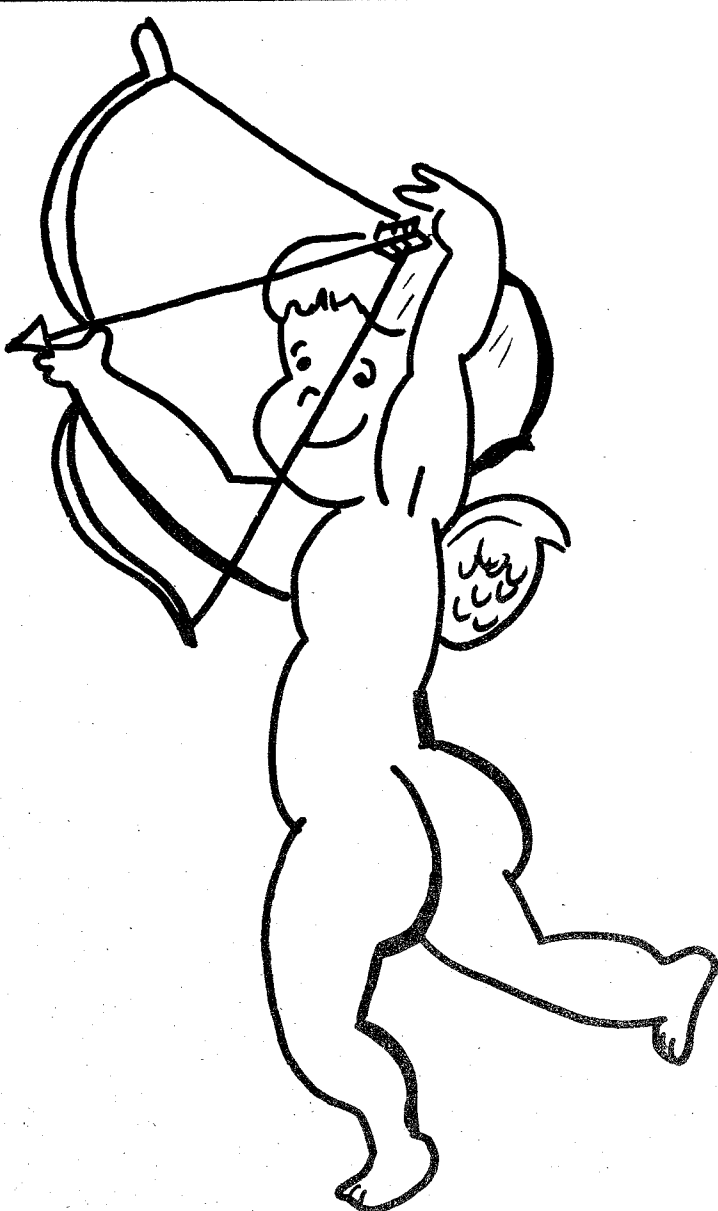
