SU Bridge Advisory Committee

Recommendation of the University Academic Assessment Committee

The SU Bridge program was approved by the SU Faculty Senate on December 3rd, 2013, as a replacement for Fall Fusion, and will enroll students beginning in Fall 2014. During preliminary discussions of this program, three Senate committees were consulted and provided support and/or feedback: Admissions and Readmissions, Long Range Academic Planning, and University Academic Assessment. While the program was supported by the Senate, some aspects of SU Bridge were not yet finalized, and the Administration has asked for faculty assistance in its development.

Therefore, we recommend that an *ad hoc* advisory committee representing the three committees named above be created to work with the appropriate administrators on this program, so faculty concerns and questions are adequately addressed.

- A) Each of these three committees—Admissions and Readmissions, Long Range Academic Planning, and University Academic Assessment—will identify 1 or 2 members who will participate in this committee, and provide their names and contact information to Associate Provost Dr. Melanie Perreault.
- B) Whenever appropriate, this committee will be consulted by administrative offices and personnel, including but not limited to the Provost's Office and the Office of Admissions.
- C) The committee will report to the Senate on developments or concerns about the program and, if necessary, make recommendations for additional Senate action on SU Bridge.
